VISIT DOURO IN ARMAMAR

The landscape on the North of the municipality is marked by the great amphitheater of vines where the Douro wines, with particular emphasis on the world famous Porto wine, are grown and produced.

During the spring, the area is bounded by long and green rows of vines that show the beauty of the characteristic geometric plantations. In autumn, after the harvest, the landscape changes colour. The red and brown colours announce the end of a production cycle.

The circuit Visit the Douro in Armamar allows you to get to know the Douro Valley, where fruity, white and red wines are produced, which are recognized internationally.

Going up and down, through the slopes of the Douro in Armamar also means meeting the birthplace of the production of the famous Porto wine, initially in the charge of the Cistercian monks in Quinta dos Frades.

A rich and valuable heritage follows the visitor during the route and shows the importance of the municipality over the centuries.

Armamar is located on a steep hillside and touching the cascade of Misarela, a point from where it is possible to admire the beautiful Douro landscape. It is the seat of the municipality. The infrastructures and services that support the entire population are concentrated here. Amongst the historical heritage, the Church of São Miguel de Armamar (Romanesque), classified National Monument, deserves a special attention.


The origin of Vila Nova dates back to the 12th century or even before the Nationality. This village has as tradition the homemade industries of milk-food and meat, resulting from the shepherd activity. It is known as the land of the goat cheese and another product that is one of the best labels of Armamar: the kid (small goat).

Marmelal was one of the first councils in the land of Armamar. It had charter in 1194. The place is amazing due to the landscape that can be watched from there: the Douro River at the bottom, with the mouth of the Tedo River that joins it, framed by the beauty of the terraced vineyards where the grapes are grown for the production of excellent Douro and Porto wines.

Folgosa is the most northern parish in the municipality. It is located on the left bank of the Douro River. The economy is based on agriculture, with the cultivation of vineyards, which produce grapes of excellent quality for the Porto and Douro wines. The cultivation of olive trees is also important, resulting in the existence of transforming industries of oil and olive oil.

Santo Adrião is located on the Northeast side of the municipality and is limited on the East by Tabuaço. The population is dedicated to hard work in the Douro farms. In addition to wine, good olive oil and oranges are also produced.

Coura is the smallest parish of the municipality. The poor and sandy soil and the steep slopes imposed an agriculture practiced in small pieces of land, where potatoes, apples and chestnuts were produced. The village still retains much of the architecture of a mediaeval town in its alleys and houses.
